On the 27th of April - Valencia, we - the farmers of the European Union decided on the following points:

- 1. We demand the withdrawal of the provisions associated with the so-called New Green Deal. The regulations of the New Green Deal undermine the competitiveness of European agriculture by increasing the costs of agricultural production in Europe and causing a reduction in European agricultural production, driving European farmers to the brink of bankruptcy. For all EU Citizens the New Green Deal also threatens food security (even more with a war on the EU borders!) and food safety. Additionally, the New Green Deal leads to clearing of (rain) forest as necessary food production is relocated.
- 2. We demand the absolute protection of the European Union's internal market. We firmly oppose the influence of agri-food products into the European Union from Morocco, Ukraine, and other countries outside the community. At the same time, we oppose the conclusion by the EU of free trade agreements that harm European agriculture and agri-food processing, especially agreements with Mercosur, India, etc. We claim for communitary preference in the EU.
- 3. We demand protection and support for the European animal farming and breeding sector. We do not agree to the restriction of any sector of animal production because their development is an important element of stability in plant production and food security in Europe. Regardless of the species of animals fur animals, cattle, pigs, or poultry their breeding should be maintained in Europe.
- 4. **We demand the absolute protection of the right to use private property.** We do not agree to attempts to take control of our land, our beaches, and the sea from which we derive benefits. We claim for State Members Sovereignty.

Statement for the EU Citizens:

EU food production is the most sustainable in the world! Every legislation or demand coming from 'Brussels' that leads to reducing EU food production, is in contradiction with the climate goals, the sustainability demands and therefore is in contradiction with the interests of you, the EU citizens. Let's reclaim our European Union from the sledgehammers from Brussels.

Vote them away between the 6th and the 9th of June: the EU elections.
